

News of the Day

In a call issued for several consecutive days, students from several major universities in Iran held protest gatherings on 22 February in memory of those killed in the month of Dey and in protest against the repression and arrest of students.

- Sharif Univ. of Technology: gathering in front of the Computer Engineering Faculty; clashes with Basij forces and dispersal.
- Amirkabir Univ. of Technology: gathering on campus; resistance against attacks by Basij members.
- Univ. of Tehran: gathering in front of the Central Library and the main gate.
- Iran Univ. of Science and Technology: large scale gathering; clashes with Basij forces.
- Shahid Beheshti Univ.: sit in at the main building.
- K N Toosi Univ. of Technology and Univ. of Art of Iran: gatherings confronted by pro government forces.
- Univ. in Mashhad, Ferdowsi Univ. and Sajjad Univ.: protest gatherings.

These protests were largely met with repression. The wave of demonstrations that began after Dey continues

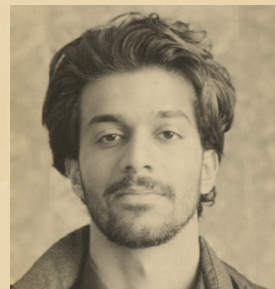

Hozayfeh Oustakh, an 11 year old Baloch child, was killed on 9 January in Shahid Rajaei, Har Street, Mashhad after being shot in the chest and abdomen by Islamic Republic forces.

During the fortieth day memorial on 16 February in Mashhad, 18 year old **Arian Nabati** was shot near Pirouzi Boulevard and died. He was hit by three bullets. The hospital initially reported the cause of death as a traffic accident, though evidence indicates gunshot wounds.
