

News of the Day : *Speak of the executed*

At dawn on February 26, 2026, death sentences of at least 12 prisoners were carried out in prisons in Mahabad, Shiraz, Malayer, Lahijan, Gonabad, Chabahar, Damghan, Bushehr, Shahrekord, Sabzevar, Kashmar, and Mashhad. They had previously been sentenced to death in separate cases on charges such as murder and drug related offenses, described as false by rights sources.

According to HRANA, those executed were Kianoush Manouri, Ghader Mohammadi, Nariman Zangeneh, Ali Asghar Oladi, Shateri, Mostafa Kamali, Aysan Rostami, Jahan Azadi, Farshid Ghasemi, Taher Yousefi, Hamid Tajik, and Adel Fereshteh. Nine were executed on murder charges and three on drug related charges.

As of this report, officials have not publicly announced the executions.

Political Prisoners

Detainees are held in silence and without information; many are denied access to legal counsel, and their families are kept unaware of their condition. Some face heavy sentences, including death, without transparent notification or fair trial proceedings.

Citizens who are killed in silence

Amirhossein Eshghi, 18, and his 14 year old brother Arian Eshghi,

both students, were killed during the January protests in Tehran. On January 8, Amirhossein was shot outside Police Station 153 in Yaftabad, first in the back and then twice in the chest and heart. Arian was shot in the throat at the same location that day and died a day later.

Hamed Hormozi, a 19 year old Baluch from Zabol,

was violently arrested during a raid on his home by IRGC intelligence forces and taken to an undisclosed location. Since his abduction, no official information has been released about his condition, whereabouts, or legal status
